Official Rules and Regulations

1. Entry fee of \$30 is due with completed registration. One salsa recipe per individual, per team or family. Each contestant will receive 1 Fiery Foods Festival T-shirts.
2. Sampling fee \$5 script (ticket) for unlimited sampling of salsas by general public. Scripts may be purchased at the Information Booth.
3. All contestants must register by completing the official registration form with entry fee. Incomplete registration forms or those submitted without an entry fee will not be considered. Contest registrations may be submitted in three ways with entry fee of \$30 (checks or cash only please):

 - c. Walk-ins M-F, 9:00 am-4:00 pm: 110 S. 4th Avenue, Pasco, WA 99301
4. All salsa recipes must be original and owned outright by each participating contestant including:
 - a. All salsas will be freshly prepared on Saturday, September 10, 2022 and not pre-made beforehand.
 - b. All contestants will provide a name for their salsa.
 - c. All contestants will provide a list of ingredients.
5. By signing the entry form, all contestants agree to the terms and conditions outlined in One Hot Salsa Official Contest Rules and Regulations and that all award decisions are final and binding.
6. Each contestant is required to produce a minimum of one gallon of their salsa recipe for sampling by the general public. Contestants are welcome to produce more if preferred.
7. All contestants must apply and receive a Benton/Franklin Food Worker's card no later than Friday, September 1, 2022-no exceptions. Food Worker cards may be obtained through a class or online at: <http://www.bfhd.wa.gov/eh/fsfwc.php>
8. Required contestant meeting at 8:00 am, Saturday, September 10, 2022, at Pasco Specialty Kitchen (PSK). This is a mandatory meeting to cover Benton Franklin Health Department and PSK rules and regulations.

9. Contestants are required to bring their own ingredients, tools, serving utensils and one clean, closed gallon container (with secure lid).
10. The Pasco Specialty Kitchen will be the production facility for all salsa entries. PSK is available at 7:00 am-5:00 pm Saturday, September 10. Food deliveries can be scheduled on Friday, September 9, 2022 from 9:00 am-5:00 pm. Only cold storage will temporarily be available.
11. No one under the age of 14 is allowed in PSK facility for salsa contest preparation due to insurance liability.
12. Awards
 - Grand Champion: Trophy+ \$250 cash prize. Determined by ballot votes combined from Media Judge Panel AND general public.
 - Media Judges Award: Ribbon + \$150 cash prize.
 - People's Choice Award: Ribbon + \$100 cash prize.
13. Judging criteria-Media Judge Panel only:
 - Presentation-20 points
 - Taste-20 points
 - Creativity of recipe-20 points
 - Quality of fresh ingredients-20 points
 - Sourced locally: List local ingredients (identify which ingredients are purchased from grower/farmer at Pasco Farmer's Market, other local sources including home-grown)-20 points
14. Contest Registration. Complete contest registrations with entry fee of \$30 may be submitted in three ways: Via email, walk-ins and through regular USPS mail. #3 above.
15. Supplies-Pasco Specialty Kitchen. PSK will supply the following for each contestant:
 - Tortilla chips
 - 2 oz sample cups
 - Plastic gloves
 - Hairnets
 - Commercial kitchen facilities--official location for salsa making.
16. Supplies-Contestants. All contestants will supply their own ingredients and supplies including but not limited to: All food ingredients, mixing utensils and tools, storage containers, 1-one gallon container with lid, name of salsa, list of ingredients (and where they are sourced).
